### **INSTALLING A GM400 OR GM650**


Properly tighten all mounting bolts. To ensure that all rod holders can tilt to running position, do not install the center of the mount more than 4.0" from the inside of the gunwale edge **(see figure 1).** If possible allow  $5-\frac{3}{4}$ " (145mm) clearance below the gunwale **(see figure 2)** to allow use of Burnewiin knives.

An installation template is shown in figure 3.



#### INBOARD EDGE OF GUNWALE OR BOLSTER

Note: This 4" constraint is only necessary for the vertical position of the RH3740 and RH5710 rod holder. The inboard edge of the gunwale or bolster can be as much as 8" for the 45 degree vertical position of the RH6650.
